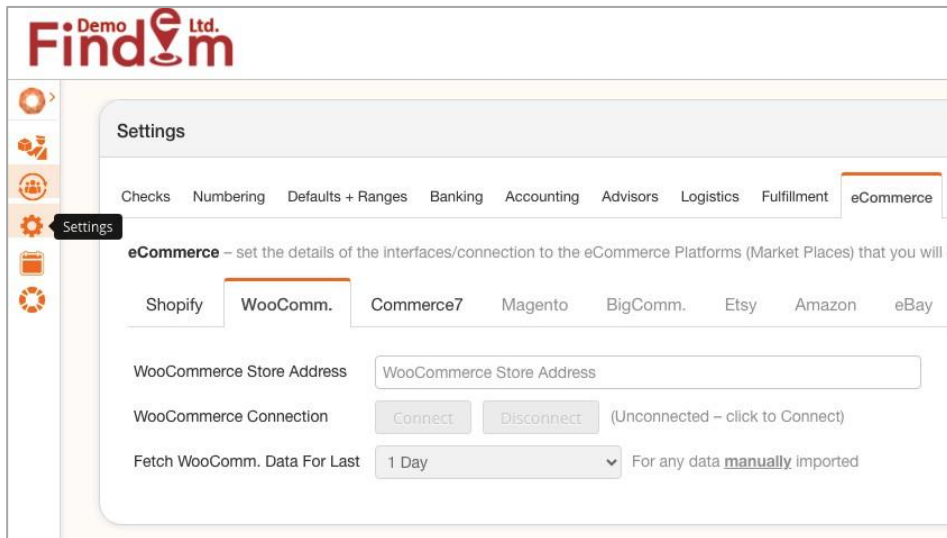
## Overview

This guide shows you how to install and connect your WooCommerce store with EdgeTariff so that the plugin can provide the functionality for Product Pre-Classification (PPC), Estimated Duties C Taxes (EDT) and Restricted Party Screening (RPS).

## Pre-Requisite Steps

Before starting with this guide make sure that you have:

1. Access and authority to install plugins into your WooCommerce store.
2. Signed up to and EdgeCTP (<https://edgectp.com/signup/>) and have received the relevant login credentials on your sign-up email address.
3. Confirmed that the EdgeCTP login is working and you have logged in successfully.
4. Connected your WooCommerce store to EdgeCTP (i.e., **Settings > eCommerce > WooComm.**) and set the relevant store connection details.



Having completed the above steps, you can now continue with the remainder of this guide, in sequence, to conclude the finish of EdgeTariff.

# Installing the EdgeTariff plugin

You can install the EdgeTariff plugin using **either of the two methods below**:

## Option 1: Install from WordPress Plugin Directory (Recommended)

1. Go to **WordPress Admin → Plugins → Add New Plugin**
2. In the search bar, type "**EdgeTariff**"
3. Locate the **EdgeTariff** plugin
4. Click **Install Now**
5. After installation, click **Activate**

## Option 2: Install by Uploading the Plugin ZIP File

1. Download the **EdgeTariffWooCommPlugin.zip** file

*Note: Get the EdgeTariffWooCommPlugin.zip file from within EdgeCTP (Settings > eCommerce > WooComm.) or download from WordPress Plugins Directory.*

2. Go to **WordPress Admin → Plugins → Add New Plugin → Upload Plugin**
3. Upload the ZIP file
4. Click **Install Now**, then click **Activate**

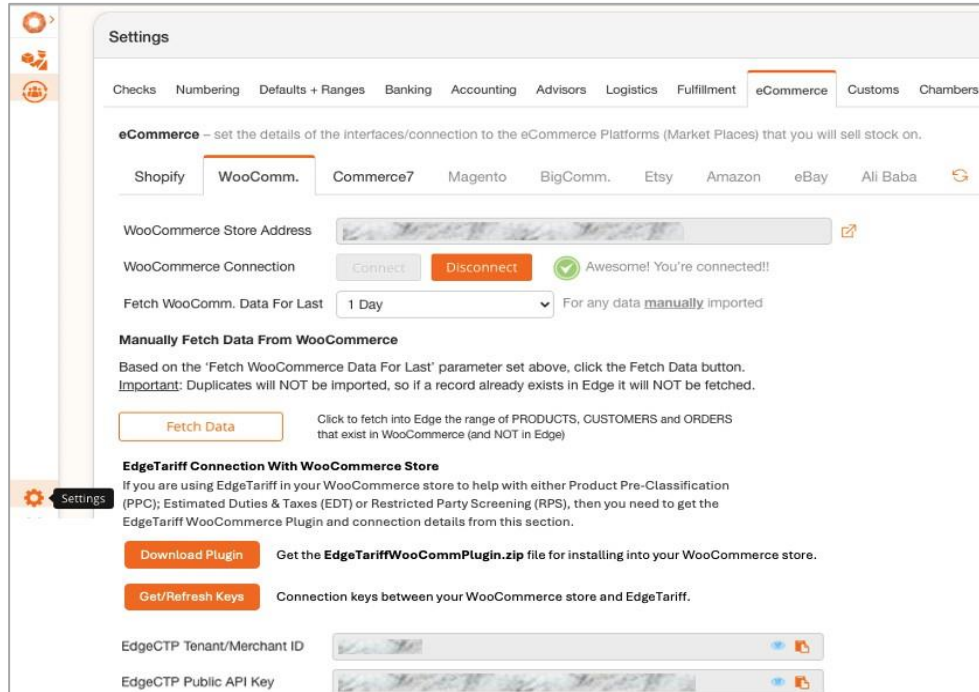
## After Activation

Once activated, the system will **automatically redirect you to the EdgeTariff setup screen**.

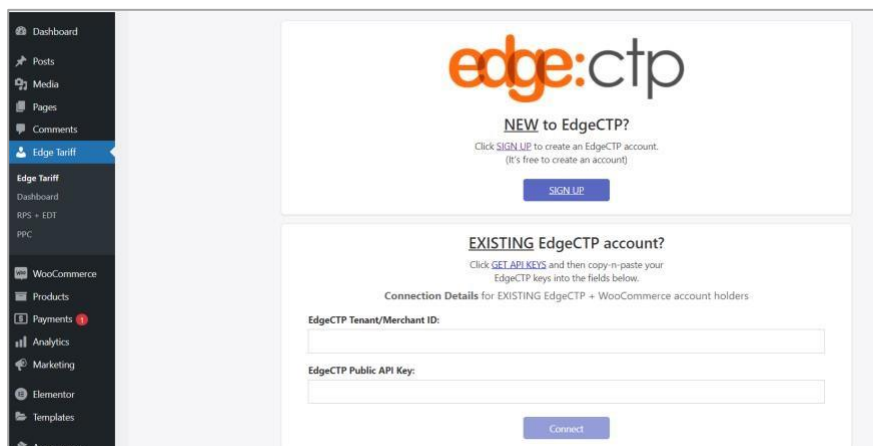
# Connecting WooCommerce with EdgeTariff

This section shows you how to connect your WooCommerce store with EdgeTariff.

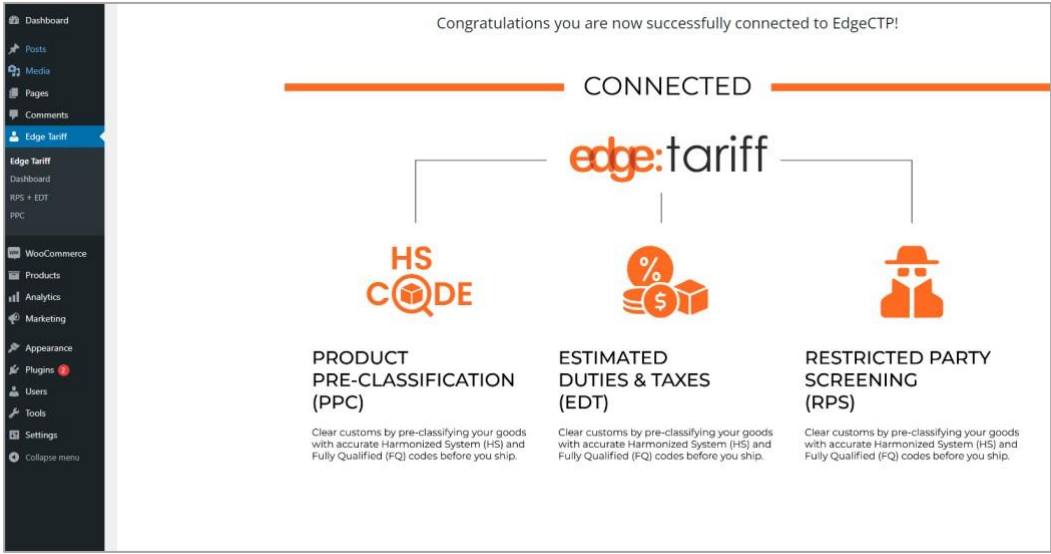
1. Login to EdgeCTP and navigate to **Settings > eCommerce > WooComm.** and make sure you have access to the Connection Keys.



2. You now need to **copy** the two keys: **EdgeCTP Tenant/Merchant ID** and **EdgeCTP Public API Key** and **paste** them into the connection section of the EdgeTariff plugin in your WooCommerce store.
3. Login to your WooCommerce store and in the left menu, click on **EdgeTariff** and add/paste the connection keys from EdgeCTP into the **EdgeCTP Tenant/Merchant ID** and **EdgeCTP Public API Key** values.



- 4. Click on **Connect** button and wait a few moments for the connection to be established.
- 5. Once the connection is established you will see the Connected screen.



You have now connected the EdgeTariff plugin from your WooCommerce store to EdgeTariff in EdgeCTP.

# Basic Functionality of EdgeTariff

This section covers the basic functionality of EdgeTariff based on PPC, EDT and RPS. Perform this section to test that EdgeTariff is setup correctly within your WooCommerce store.

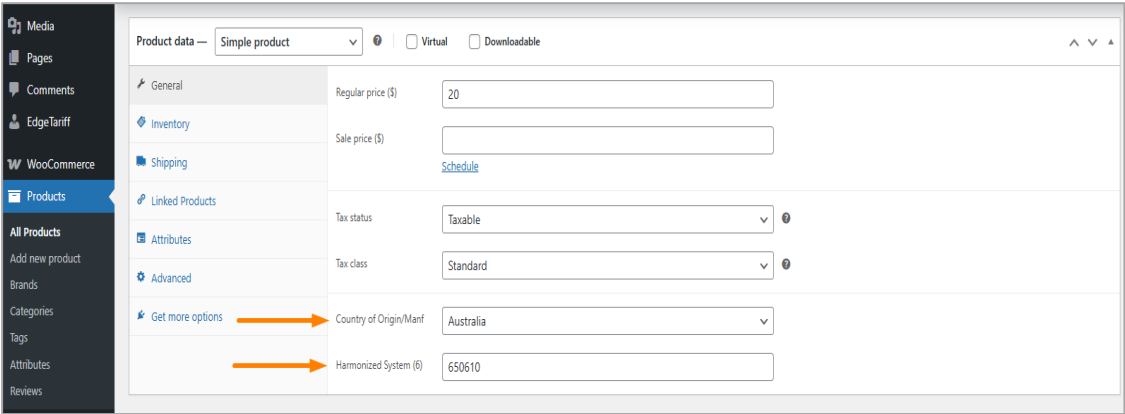
## Product Pre-Classification (PPC)

To calculate the duties & taxes of any product being shipped to a destination country, the Harmonized System (HS) code (of at least 6-digits) and Country of Origin (where a product has been made, i.e., where the greatest economic activity on the product creation took place) need to be pre-populated.

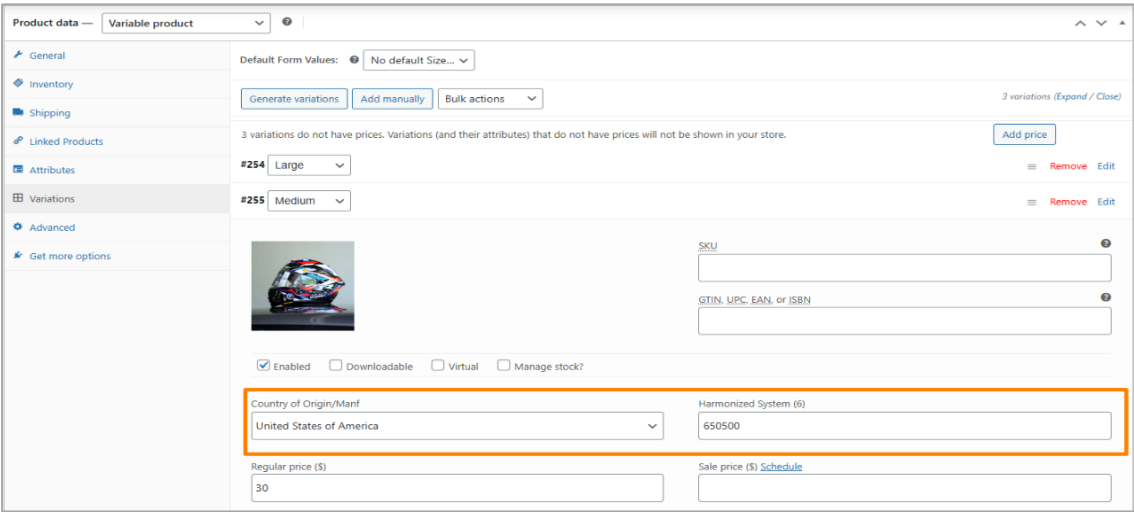
You can either perform this Product Pre-Classification (PPC) manually, one-product at a time based on what you know is the HS code, or use the PPC functionality to request a trained customs expert to classify the product for you.

### Manually Add Country of Origin and HS6 Code Values

1. For each SIMPLE product, edit and add the Country of origin/manuf. and Harmonised System HS6 code values.



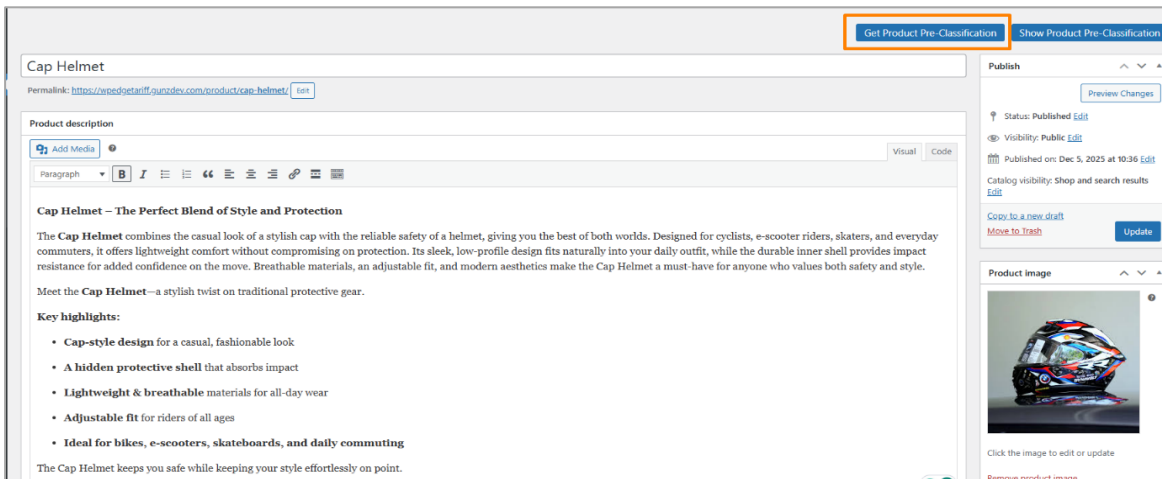
2. Additionally for each VARIANT/VARIATION product, edit and add the Country of origin/manuf. and harmonized code HS6 code values.



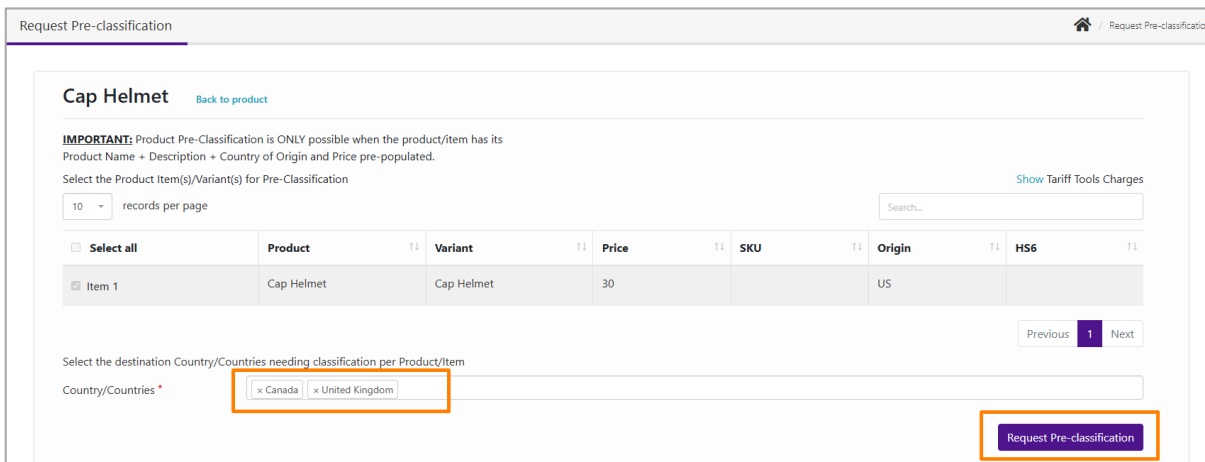
## Get Professional Product Pre-Classification (PPC) Service

If you would prefer a customs' trained professional to pre-classify your product(s) to BOTH HS6 (first 6-digits) and country specific Fully Quality (FQ) level (10-digits or more), then follow this process.

1. Find and **edit** the product you wish to get classified.
2. Click on **Get Product Pre-Classification** button at the top right.



3. When requested, add the **country or countries** you MAY ship the product to and click on **Request Pre-classification** button.



**Note:** Product Pre-classification is performed by a HUMAN and therefore, could take an hour or so to be classified and returned to you, i.e., there is NO immediate classification shown.

- 4. You can on occasion come into the **EdgeTariff > PPC** to show the Product Pre- Classification (PPC) table, where you can click on the **refresh** icon, under the Action column, to see that classification done for the product.

- 5. The returned value should be shown in the **HS6** and **Tariff Code** columns (both HS6 + Tariff Code = the **Fully Qualified** value that is country specific), with EdgeTariff automatically populating the HS6 value for the product in the WooCommerce store.

## Perform Estimate Duty and Tax (EDT)

This section assumes that an overseas buyer is purchasing an item from your online store.

Additionally, to show the shipping rates along with the duties & taxes, you will need to make sure that the shipping rates connection (to a carrier) or your own shipping rates has been setup within EdgeCTP **Settings > Shipping > Logistics**.

To see EDT on the checkout, do the following:

1. Go to the online store and select an item(s) to purchase by placing them into the cart.
2. Process to the checkout and complete the required DESTINATION address fields.
3. Wait for the checkout to appear showing the **shipping rates automatically** with the associated **Duties & Taxes** for each shipping method.

4. If you are simply testing this functionality on a LIVE environment, then you can abandon the cart here, otherwise, you can place the order and look at the confirmed order in your order screen within WooCommerce.

## Restricted Party Screening (RPS)

The RPS functionality allows you to screen a customer BEFORE you ship goods to them. To perform RPS on any placed order do the following:

1. **Find** and **edit** the order you wish to screen the customer.
2. Click the **Request RPS** button

# EdgeTariff Bundled Products

## Overview

**WooCommerce** is an eCommerce platform used by merchants who have a WordPress site on which they sell their products. **EdgeTariff** is a WooCommerce-enabled plug-in, which provides merchants with the **expected duty and tax (EDT)** calculation facility on their online store's checkout when an international purchase is being made.

**EdgeTariff Bundle (ETB)** is a feature that is built-in EdgeTariff, which allows the merchant to sell bundled products (i.e., goods that have a mixture of different products within them) to international buyers. To calculate the expected duties and taxes (EDT) on bundled products being sold internationally, the EdgeTariff Bundled (ETB) functionality analyses the individual goods that make up the bundle and applies the appropriate duties and taxes, which is then shown as a total landed cost to the buyer on the check-out. The buyer can then make an informed decision to purchase the goods, rather than be surprised (or filled with buyer's remorse) on receiving the goods.

The guide shows merchants how to use ETB to create and manage bundles within the WooCommerce environment.

## Pre-Requisite Assumptions

Before following along with the examples in this guide, you need to have:

1. Access to your **WooCommerce** store admin section, along with the **correct permissions**.
2. An understanding of **how to create bundled products** in WooCommerce.
3. EdgeCTP/**EdgeTariff installed** in your WooCommerce store.
4. Your **WooCommerce store** is **already connected** within EdgeCTP/EdgeTariff, with a valid **payment card** added and both the **PPC** and **EDT** functionalities switched on.
5. Already created the **individual products** that you wish to add to -bundled products. These products can be **variable products** and specific **variations of a variable product**, e.g., Tee-shirt products in red, green, or blue color variables, and within those colors, size variations of small, medium, large, and extra-large, etc.
6. Set the **HS code classifications, Weights, and Prices** for ALL individual products that make up the constituent parts of a bundle(s).
7. **Shipping rates** account details are set within EdgeCTP/EdgeTariff to get your live shipping rates.

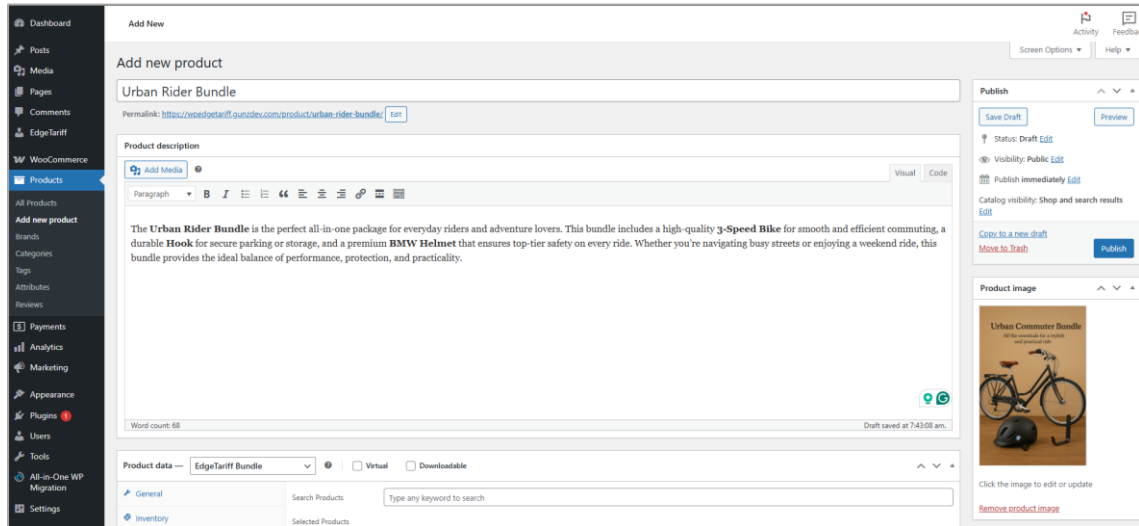
## Existing Product Bundles – Migration to ETB

If you have existing product bundles, they will need to be recreated as ETBs so that duties and taxes can be calculated on them. This is shown later in the document and onboarding assistance can be requested from [support@morgangoodwin.com](mailto:support@morgangoodwin.com) to help with any product bundle migration efforts.

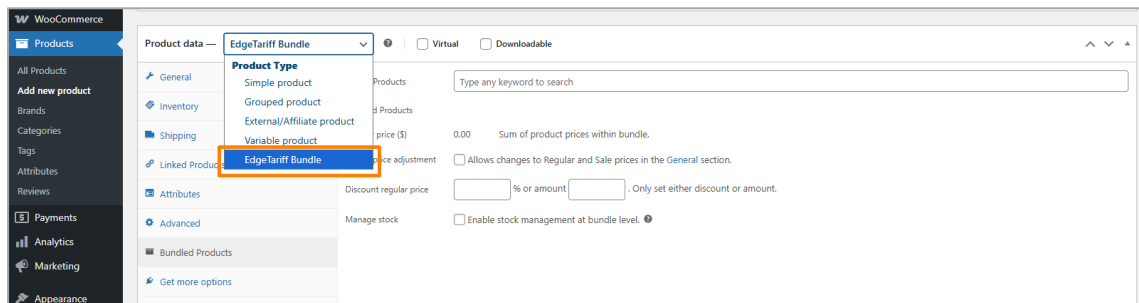
## Creating an ETB Product Bundle with WooCommerce

This section shows you how to create bundles using the EdgeTariff Bundle (ETB) functionality. It is a step- by-step example, which you can follow with your own specific bundle data.

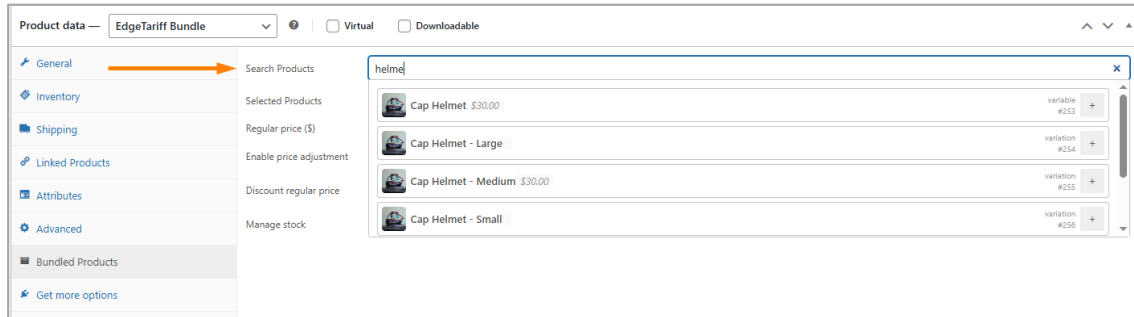
1. Login to your WooCommerce store administrator section.
2. From the left menu, select **Products > Add new product** and you can begin creating the bundle as normal by entering the **Product name**, **Product description**, and **Product gallery**.



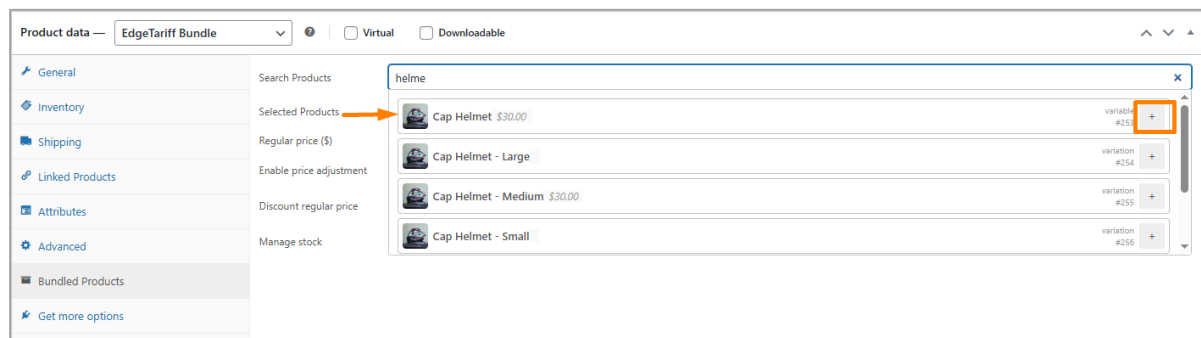
3. Scroll down to the **Product data** section and select the **EdgeTariff Bundle** to make this product category an ETB bundle.



4. In the left menu, scroll down and click on the **Bundled Products** to begin adding your products to the bundle.
  - a. Begin by using the **Search Products** field to locate products that are non-bundled products, i.e., you can search for variable products and specific variations of a variable product.



- b. From the search result, select the desired product that you wish to add to the new bundle and click the **add [+]** button.



- c. Repeat the searching and adding of products (above two steps), until all the desired products have been added to the new bundle.

5. Once all the products have been added to the bundle:
- Check that the correct **products**, their **quantities**, and **variables** are in the bundle. You can *remove* products by simply clicking the **remove [x]** button on the *right* of the product line. To *rearrange* the order of the products, within a bundle, simply click on the **up/down** button and drag the product line up or down accordingly.



- Discount regular price** – an optional setting that allows you to apply a percentage or amount discount on the regular price. For example, if the Regular price was \$150 and you applied a 50% **discount**, then the Sale price of the bundle would be \$75. Alternatively, if you added an **amount** of \$51, then the Sale price of the bundle would be \$99.
- Manage Stock** – an optional setting that allows you to manage stock at the bundle level and links to the Inventory section of the product bundle settings.

- Optionally*, if you want WooCommerce to manage the inventory of the bundle product, click on the **Inventory** menu (left side) set the inventory settings accordingly, and potentially set the Product categories if required.
- For the transport packing of the bundle, click on **Shipping** from the left menu and LEAVE this as a DEFAULT value because you will set the packaging methods in EdgeCTP/EdgeTariff later.

- You are now ready to publish privately the bundled product, Now set visibility as Private, just click on the **Publish** button to finish creating the bundle product within WooCommerce.

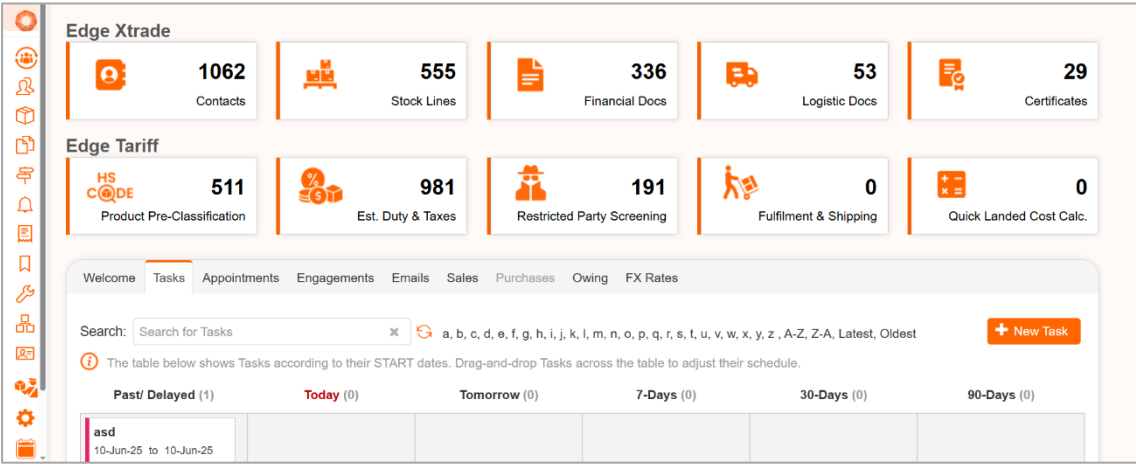
You now need to fetch this privately created bundle product from WooCommerce into EdgeCTP/EdgeTariff.

# Fetch ETB Product Bundles into EdgeCTP from WooCommerce

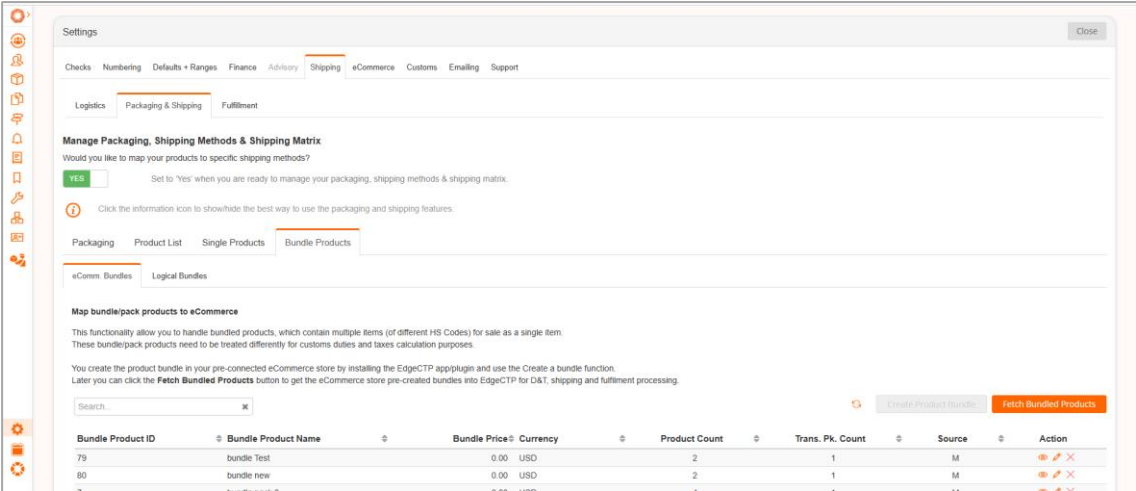
After creating the bundle in WooCommerce, you now need to fetch the newly created bundle in EdgeCTP/EdgeTariff.

**Important:** If you make ANY changes to the ETB product bundle(s) within WooCommerce, then you will need to fetch the changed bundle(s) into EdgeCTP once again. That is, this fetch mechanism is like a sync tool that keeps the ETB product bundles in WooCommerce and EdgeCTP the same – for the time being this fetch/sync is run manually (steps below). Future versions of EdgeCTP will look at auto-fetching in the background.

- 1. Login to EdgeCTP and get to the home screen.

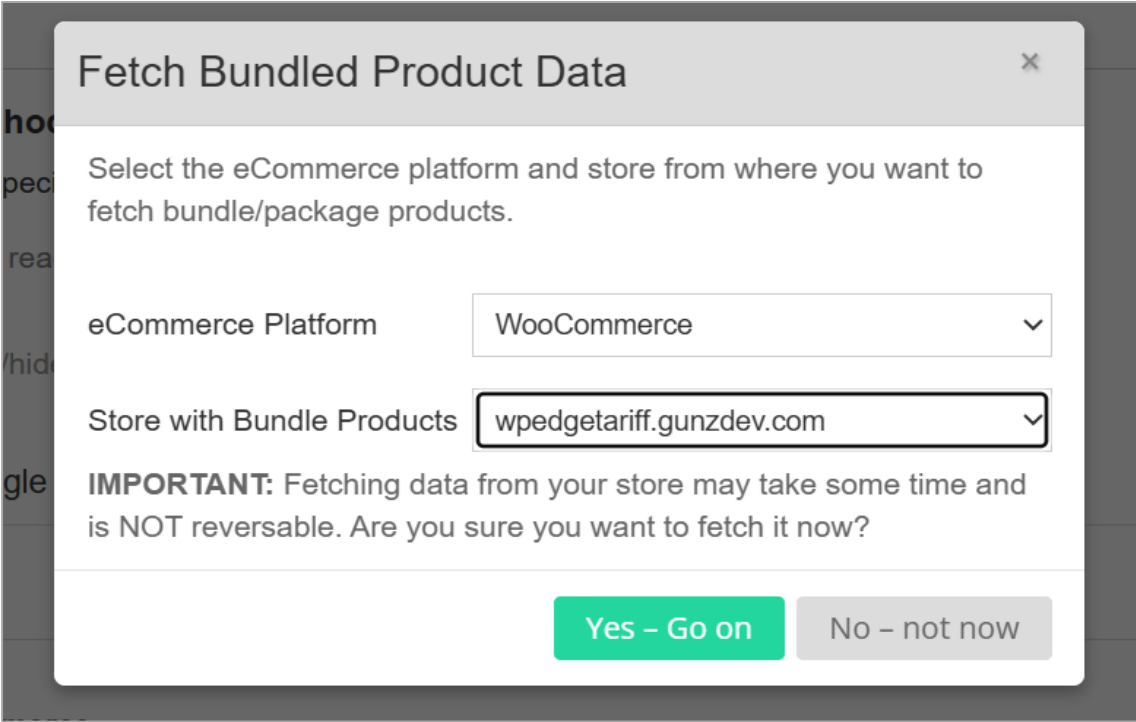


- 2. From the home screen, click on the **Settings** menu (lower left) > **Shipping > Packaging & Shipping > Bundle Products** to show the bundles screen.



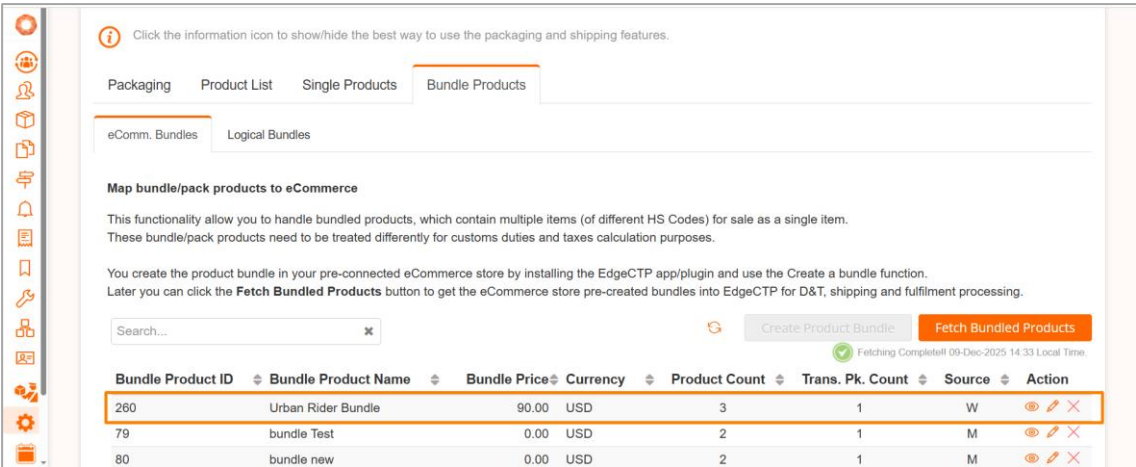
- a. **Bundle Products** – shows any existing ETB product bundles that have been fetched into EdgeCTP from WooCommerce.
- b. **Fetch Bundled Products** – use this to fetch ETB product bundles in WooCommerce into EdgeCTP for duty & tax calculation purposes.

- 3. Click the **Fetch Bundled Products** button and wait for the Fetch Bundled Products Data pop-up to appear.



- a. **eCommerce Platform** – select WooCommerce
- b. **Store with Bundle Products** – select the name of your connected WooCommerce store where the ETB products are held that you wish to fetch into EdgeCTP/EdgeTariff.
- c. **Yes - Go on** – click this button to begin the fetching of ETB product bundles.

- 4. Wait a few minutes and the ETB product bundle(s) are fetched and shown in the table.



## Adjusting Product Bundle Transport Packaging

Having fetched the ETB product bundles into EdgeCTP, you can now use the Edit (pencil icon) action to set the transport package sizing and method of the bundle.

1. Find the ETB product bundle within EdgeCTP and under action click the **Edit** (pencil icon) button.
2. Wait for the Bundled Product Details pop-up to appear.

**Important:** Each bundle needs to have **weight, length, width, height** (dimensions), and **package kind** to allow for getting the correct shipping rate, which in turn has an impact on the duties and taxes charged. Therefore, make sure that these values are correctly added to the bundle.

5. Click **Add** and then **Save** once you have set the relevant fields.

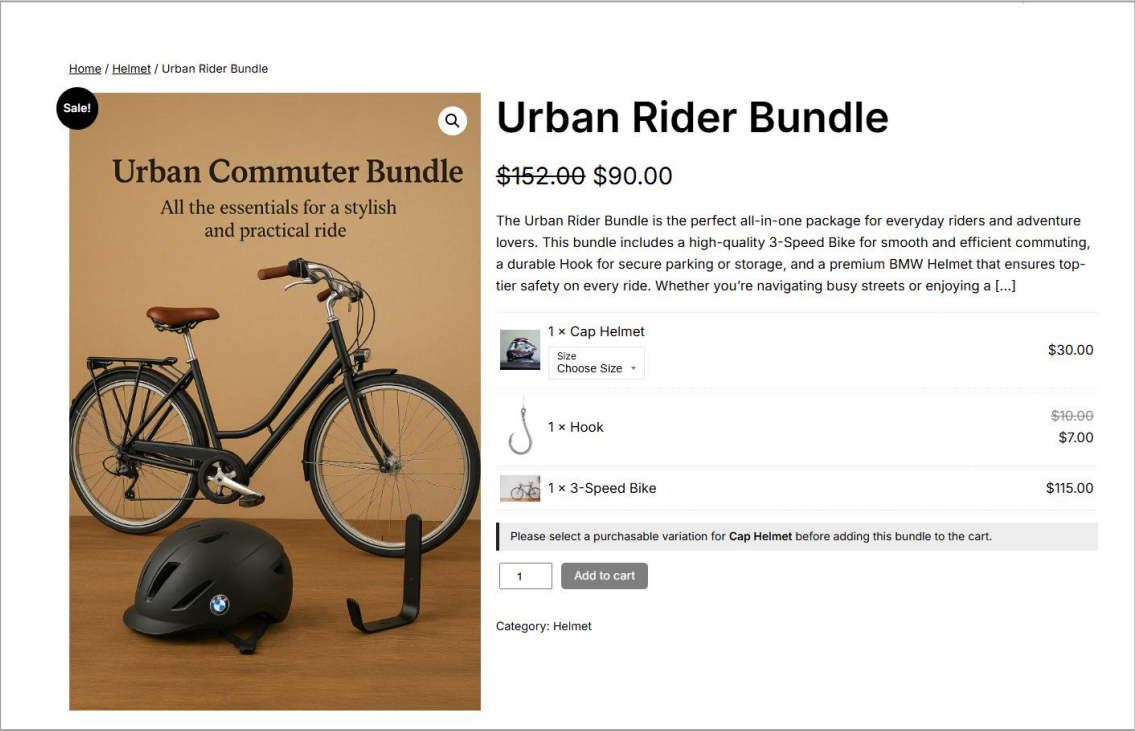

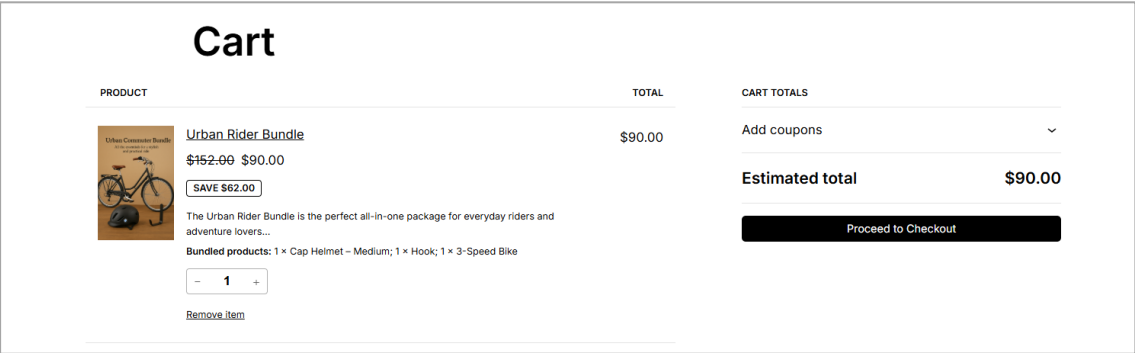
# Testing ETB Product Bundles on your Online Store

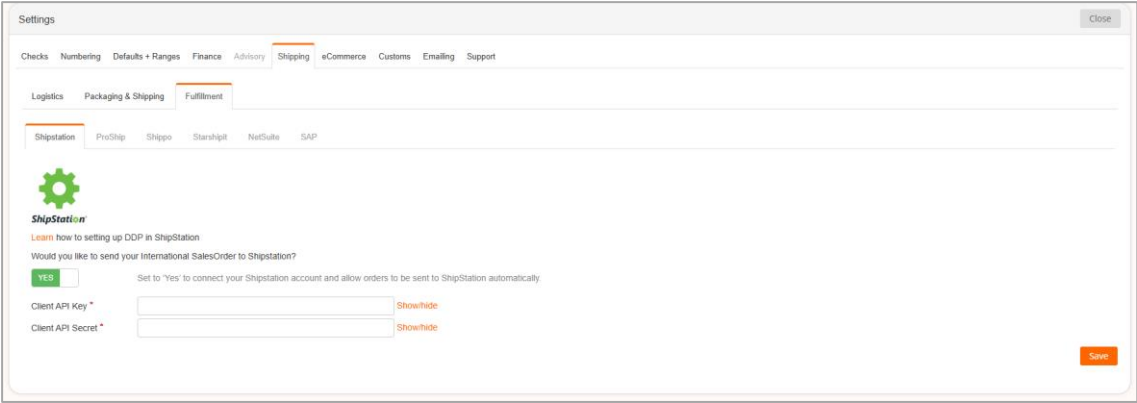

# Fulfilling and Order with ShipStation

If you plan on using ShipStation to fulfil your WooCommerce orders, which have been “tagged” as DDP (Delivery and Duty Paid) by EdgeTariff, then you will FIRST need to establish a connection between EdgeCTP and ShipStation, i.e., **EdgeCTP > Settings > Shipping > Fulfillment > ShipStation** and follow the setups to connection the two systems together.

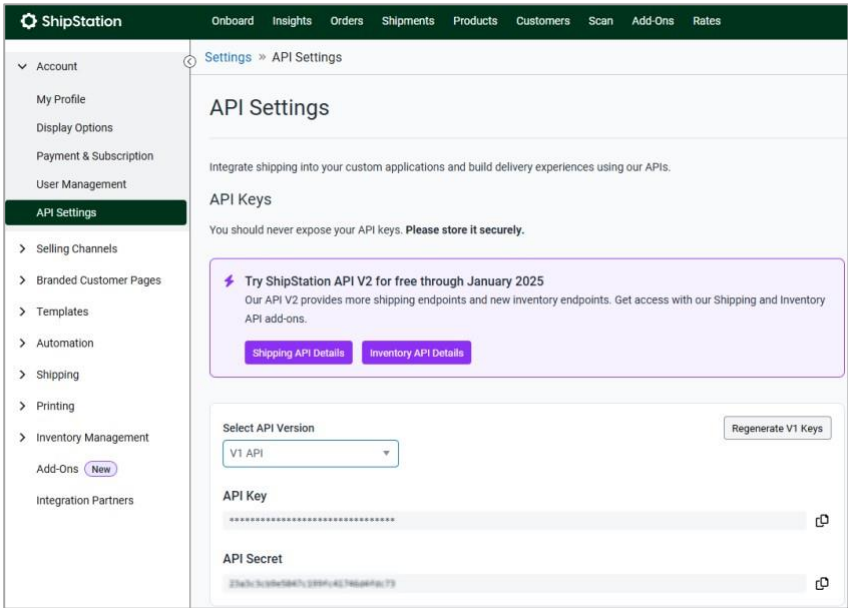


## Setting Shipping Labels as DDP

Click the **Learn** link (below the ShipStation logo) to set your consignments as DDP – Delivery and Duty Paid.

## Obtaining the API Key and Secret

Login into your ShipStation account and access the connection keys (**API Settings**), which you copy-n-paste into EdgeCTP’s **Client API Key** and **Client API Secret** fields respectively. This will allow the WooCommerce orders to flow into ShipStation (as normal).



# FedEx Auto Shipment, Label & Commercial Invoice Configuration Guide

## EdgeTariff Plugin Settings

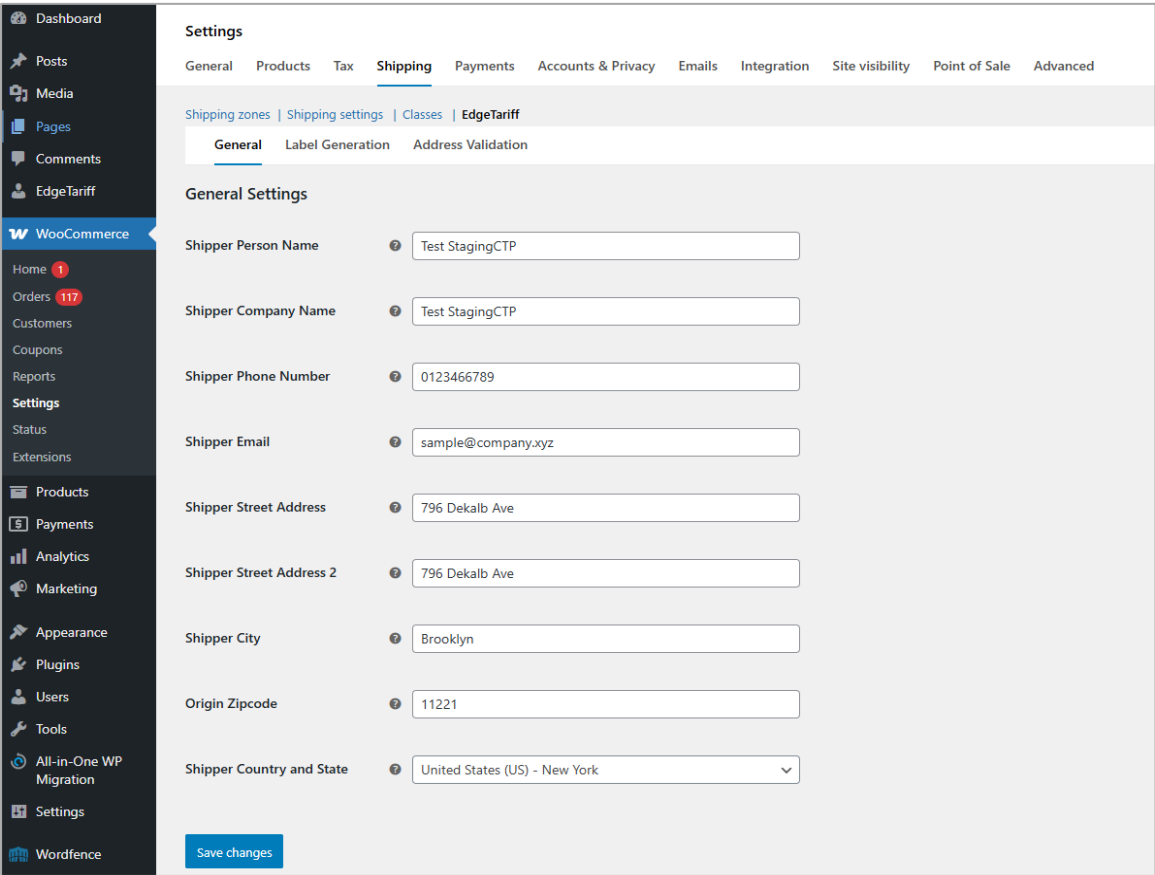
The EdgeTariff plugin settings allow the store owner to configure automatic label generation, and shipment behavior for FedEx integration. These settings are available under the following path in the WordPress admin panel:

WooCommerce → Settings → Shipping → EdgeTariff

### 1. General Settings

The **General Settings** section contains the shipper’s contact details required for generating FedEx shipping labels.

These details are used as the “From” address on shipping labels and commercial invoices, ensuring accurate and consistent shipment information.



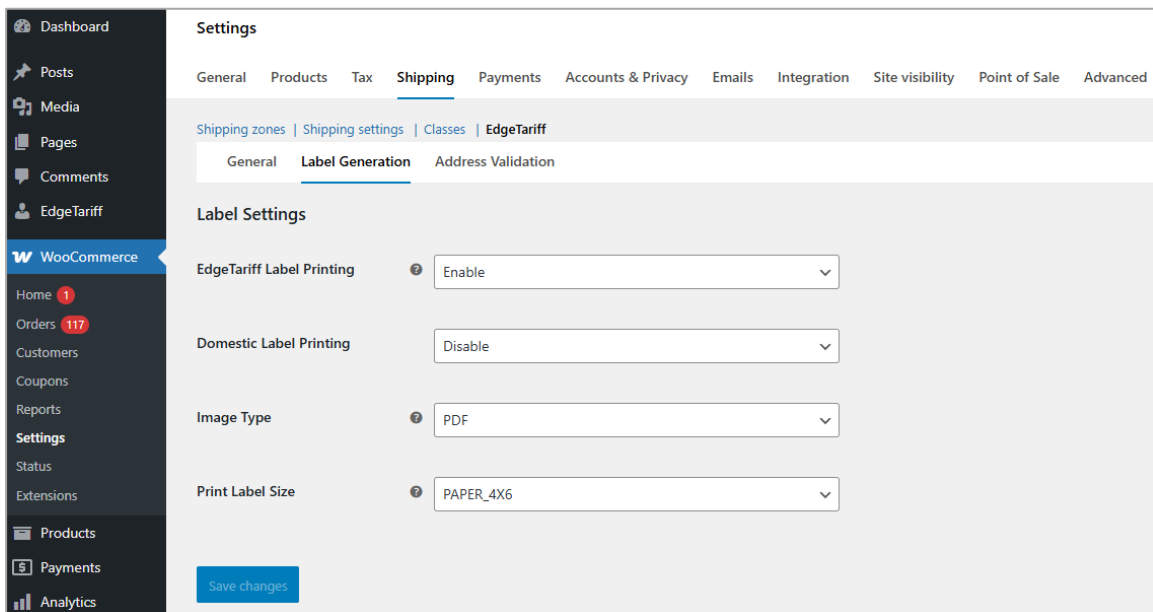
## 2. Label Generation Settings

The **Label Generation Settings** section allows you to control how FedEx shipping labels are generated and formatted.

Available options include:

- **EdgeTariff Label Printing (Enable/Disable)** – Enables or disables automatic label printing on successful order placement for EdgeTariff shipments.
- **Domestic Label Printing (Enable/Disable)** – Allows label printing for domestic shipments.
- **Image Type** – Choose your preferred label file format such as **PDF**, **PNG**, **EPL2**, or **ZPLII** depending on your printer type.
- **Print Label Size** – Select from different print sizes based on the chosen image type (for example, 4x6 or 8.5x11).

These options let store owners tailor label creation according to their preferred printing setup.

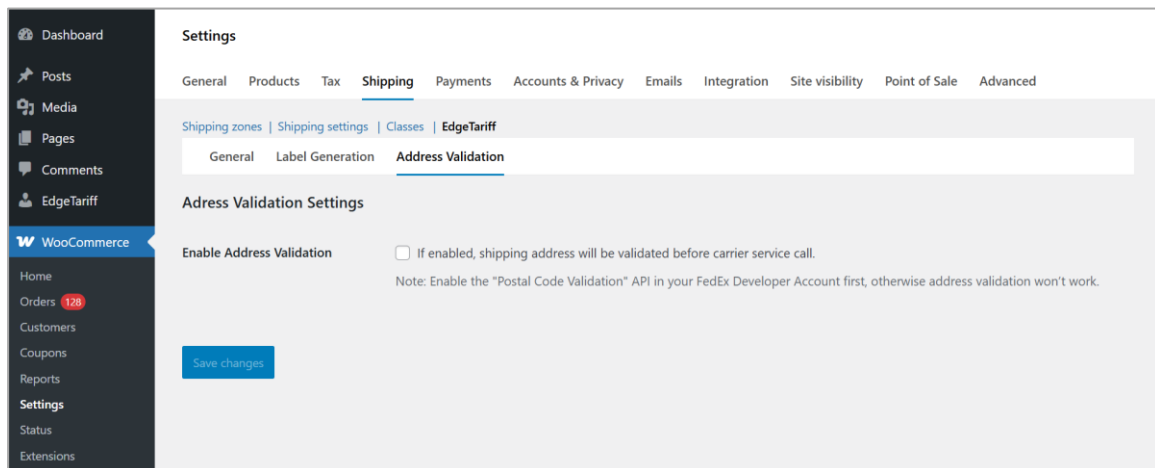


### 3. Address Validation Settings

The **Address Validation Settings** section enables address verification on the WooCommerce checkout page.

- **Enable Address Validation (Enable/Disable)** – When enabled, the system uses FedEx’s address verification service to validate customer shipping addresses in real time, helping prevent delivery errors and ensuring accurate shipping rates.

**Important Note:** You must need to enable the FedEx Postal Code API in the FedEx Developer Portal for this feature; otherwise, an error will appear on the checkout page.



## EdgeTariff – FedEx Auto Label and Commercial Invoice User Guide

This user guide explains how store owners can use the new shipment management features in the EdgeTariff WooCommerce plugin. These features include automatic label generation, manual shipment actions, commercial invoice downloads, shipment tracking, and voiding shipments.

### 1. Automatic Label and Commercial Invoice Generation

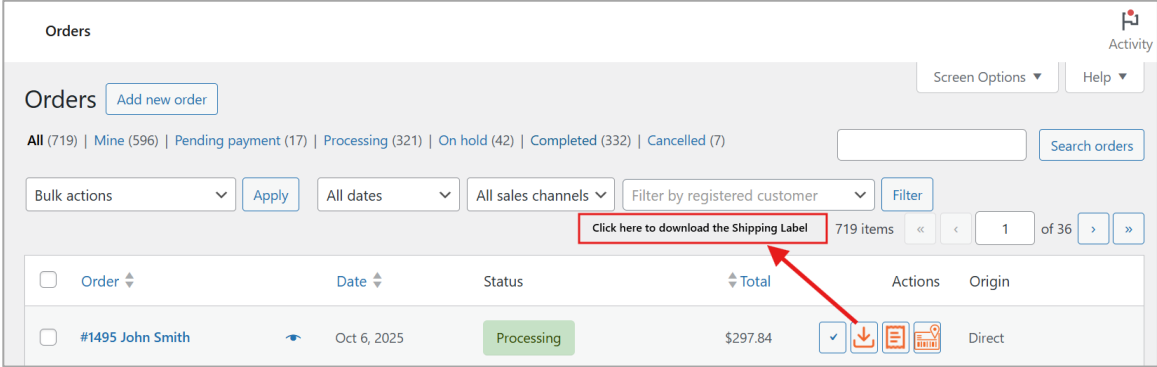
When a customer places an order on your WooCommerce store, the EdgeTariff plugin automatically communicates with the FedEx API to generate the following documents:

- Shipping Label
- Commercial Invoice

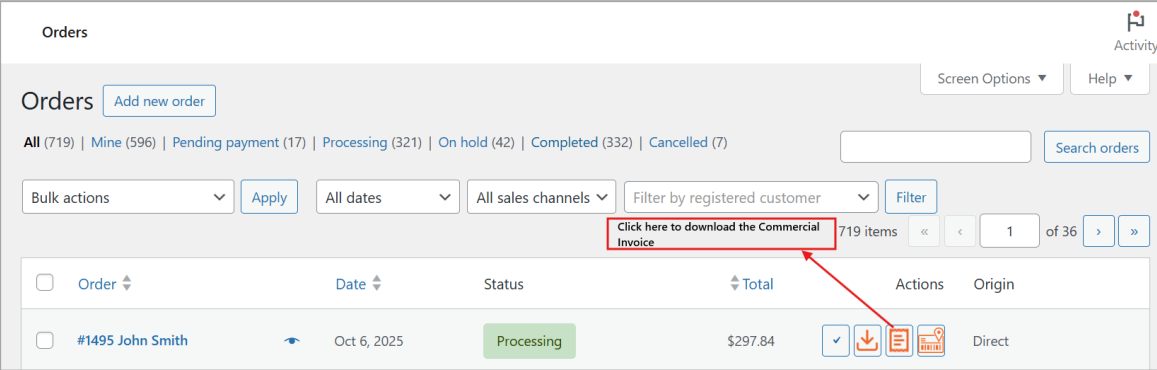
If the label and invoice are generated successfully, they are automatically attached to the order and available for download from the admin panel.

Under the **Actions** column on the WooCommerce Orders page, you will see three icons related to shipment management:

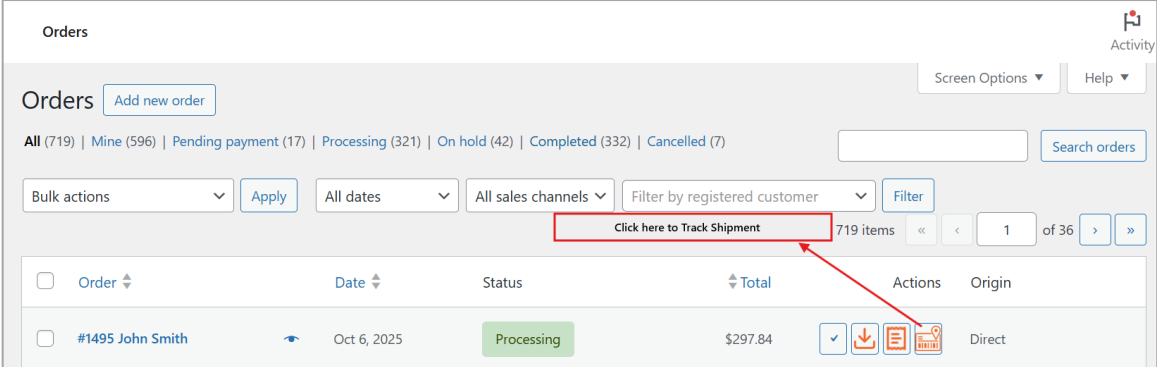
1) **Download Label Icon** – Allows downloading the shipping label after the shipment is created.



2) **Download Commercial Invoice Icon** – Enables the admin to download the generated commercial invoice.



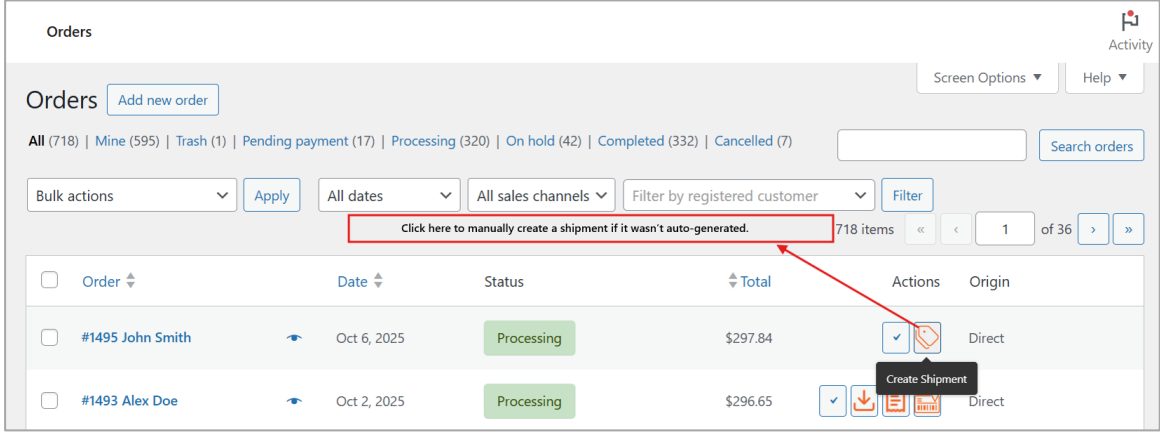
3) **Track Shipment Icon** – Provides tracking information once a FedEx shipment is active.



## 2. Manual Shipment Management (Admin Panel)

If the automatic shipment creation fails due to an API issue, the store owner can manually create and manage shipments directly from the order management page.

**Create Shipment Icon** – Used to manually create a FedEx shipment if it was not created automatically.



## 3. Voiding a Shipment

If a shipment was created but needs to be canceled (for example, due to a customer change or incorrect address), the store owner can void the shipment directly from the order page. To void a shipment:

1. Open the order from the WooCommerce admin panel.
2. On the right top you can see **Void Shipment** button.
3. Click **Void Shipment** to send a request to FedEx to cancel the shipment.
